WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires that the position of Hardin County Attorney be fulltime; and
WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has the authority under lowa Code Section 331.752 to change the Hardin County Attorney position from a part-time to a full-time position after the general election; and
WHEREAS, lowa Code Section 331.752(4) provides that the change to fulltime may take effect immediately upon agreement of the Board of Supervisors and the affected county attorney; and
WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and the affected county attorney agree to waive any delay in the effective date of the change to full-time status; and
WHEREAS, lowa Code Section 331.752(5) further requires the Board of Supervisors establish an initial fulltime salary which is subject to reviews pursuant to Iowa Code Section 331.907; and
WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has viewed and considered current actual salaries of fulltime county attorneys across lowa, as well as the compensation study prepared in December 2017 and used by the Board to set the county officials' compensation for fiscal year 2018-2019; now
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hardin County, Iowa, that the position of Harding County Attorney shall be fulltime, effective immediately; and
